From Monday 29 June, parishes will be able to celebrate public Masses. As you will see from the programme above we will have 10 am Mass each weekday morning (except Saturday) in Christ the King. While the social distancing rule has been generally reduced from 2 meters to 1 meter, it will still be 2 meters for churches. The effect of this will be to considerably reduce the capacity of the churches.

There will be volunteers at each Mass who will welcome you and help you select a seat. They will ensure that you are safe at all times.

The following are guidelines that will help you:

Guidelines for Attendance at Mass

- All doors will be open for entry to and exit from the church
- Follow social distancing advice
- Ushers will provide hand sanitiser when you come into the church
- Ushers will direct you to seats, using the front seats first (the upright supports in each seat is a good indicator of social distancing)
- Families and couples can sit together
- Holy Communion will be distributed in the normal way, seat by seat
- When Mass is over, people in the back seats leave first
- On Sundays, the ushers will hand out bulletins on the way out
